We believe in transparency in how we make our clothes and what they're made of. All fabrics have been carefully selected to meet our high standards of wearability and sustainability. Our fabrics are soft and appealing and meet the highest industrial standards

Quality standards. Most importantly, the process used to make these fabrics is sustainable and uses environmentally friendly dyes that are beneficial to the planet and your health.

Ethical fashion not only treats workers fairly, it is also based on sustainability. This means prioritizing environmentally friendly practices throughout production and making a product that has less impact on the environment. If we expect our planet not only to survive, but also to offer space for development, we must always move one step further towards sustainability and reconstruction and find new ways in which something can be realized even better, with even more excellence.

Therefore, we are not only innovative in our activism for sustainability, but also in our corporate philosophy and dealings with one another. Friendliness alone, especially in the fashion world, can be a way of rebelling.

What does ethical fashion mean for sustainability?

- The clothing is made from environmentally friendly materials such as organic, pesticide-free, non-genetically modified cotton.
- Clothing is safe for people and the environment and avoids materials that contain carcinogens, toxins or other harmful chemicals.
- Clothing is made through sustainable practices that reduce water use and waste production.
- Clothing is made with natural energy and avoiding pollution.

Ethical fashion may not solve all of our problems with unsafe chemicals, water scarcity, energy use, or overcrowded landfills. However, it allows you to reduce your environmental impact and invest in safer and more sustainable practices.

For our customers who want to know what they are wearing, we have compiled a list of the fibers used by Lia & Saora and a brief description for each of them.

MODAL

Modal is one of the softest fabrics in the world. Modal it's made from sustainable beech wood and feels silky. It feels like butter on your skin.

TENCEL ™ LYOCELL

Tencel ™ Lyocell is made from sustainable wood pulp and the yarn is manufactured in a closed cycle. This means that no water, chemicals or by-products are released into the environment. Therefore, it stays cool and comfortable while the planet stays clean.

BAMBOO RAYON

Made from bamboo pulp, a pesticide-free culture that naturally regenerates, it balances durability and softness. It is also 100% biodegradable.

ORGANIC COTTON

Organic cotton is grown without pesticides and GMOs and is a soft and breathable fabric. This is how you can feel good about yourself while feeling good about it.

LINEN

Linen comes from the resilient flax plant and is a classic staple fiber with properties such as durability, breathability and luxurious hand feel. It's also biodegradable.

Sustainable fibers fit perfectly with the philosophy of Lia & Saora as our designs are handcrafted, responsible towards nature and designed for comfort.

Sewing is the securing or fastening of objects or parts of a garment by sewing with a needle and thread, either by hand or with a sewing machine.
